



RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE

Girls feel connected to their communities by learning about the Ronald McDonald House and contributing to the House through tab collection and service projects. Troops earn the Ronald McDonald House patch the first year of participation. Those who participate additional years will earn a rocker to accompany the original patch.

GUIDELINES

All age levels collect tab tops from any brand aluminum can. Tab tops can be dropped off at the Ronald McDonald House. Visit rmhccnaz.org/poptabs or contact Adam Smith asmith@rmhccnaz.org for drop off instructions. Set your own troop goal of how many tabs to collect. To earn the Ronald McDonald Patch complete the following number of activities for each age level, including one from each category.

- » Girl Scout Daisy and Girl Scout Brownie complete 3 activities
- » Girl Scout Junior and Girl Scout Cadette complete 5 activities
- » Girl Scout Senior and Girl Scout Ambassador complete 7 activities.

DISCOVER

- » Learn how Ronald McDonald House helps sick children.
- » Research the history of the Ronald McDonald House.
- » Find out how many families are served annually at the Ronald McDonald House

CONNECT

- » Set a goal for the tab collection and collect tab tops.
- » Make an appointment to visit one of the Ronald McDonald Houses in Arizona at www.rmhccnaz.org.
- » Donate one item from the published “wish list” found on the website.
- » Make an encouragement card for the family of a sick child staying at the house.
- » Make a gift basket for a family at the Ronald McDonald House including items such as personal size toiletries, candy, gum, stationary, etc.
- » Donate a new toy or book to the Ronald McDonald House.
- » Donate Girl Scout cookies for the families.

TAKE ACTION

- » Tell at least five other people about collecting tab tops.
- » Volunteer to keep the house beautiful by helping to maintain the flowerbeds monthly.
- » Help to keep the Ronald McDonald House Cookie Jar Full by donating cookies monthly.
- » Girls age 16 and older go to the Ronald McDonald House and bake cookies or help cook a meal for the families.
