



ARCHERY

Before completing this charm, girls should have completed the Wild Wonders Patch and First-Aid charm.

This is progressive. No matter the level, girls must demonstrate all points from the previous level in order to complete their level.

BROWNIE (GRADES 2-3)

Demonstrate to an archery trained adult that you know and understand the following:

- » Identify what the whistles/commands in archery mean.
- » Identify the archery safety equipment and how to properly put it on.
- » Understand the parts of the bow and arrow.

JUNIOR (GRADES 4-5)

Demonstrate to an archery trained adult that you know and understand the following:

- » Identify parts of a bow and arrow.
- » Identify what the whistles/commands in archery mean.
- » Identify the archery safety equipment and how to properly put it on.
- » Identify and use properly the wait line, shooting line on an archery range.
- » Explain "dry fire" and why it is dangerous.
- » Proper way to hold a bow when waiting to shoot and when shooting.

CADETTE (GRADES 6-8)

Demonstrate to an archery trained adult that you know and understand the following:

- » Identify and follow whistle commands.
- » Identify archery equipment, parts of the bow, parts of the arrow.
- » Identify and use properly the wait line, shooting line on an archery range.
- » Show proper form when holding, loading, and shooting a bow.
- » Properly pull an arrow from the target.
- » Properly retrieve an arrow that has gone off target (in front and/or behind).
- » Identify the different parts of a compound bow and a recurve bow.

SENIORS AND AMBASSADORS (GRADES 9-12 + ADULTS)

- » Demonstrate to an archery trained adult that you know and understand the following:
 - Know the proper safety zones for indoor and outdoor ranges, as well as proper measurements for targets, waiting line, shooting line, and target line.
 - Know how to measure arrow to fit your height.
 - Know how to store equipment.

- Inspect equipment for damage or breakage.
- » Know how to repair equipment and/or where to get repair assistance.
- » Challenge yourself on the archery range:
 - Use smaller targets/balloons or move farther from the target when shooting.
 - Use a different type of bow (compound, longbow).
 - Use a different stance (kneel down, shoot with the opposite hand).
