

VOTING MEMBER JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: COUNCIL VOTING MEMBER

Responsible to: Girl Scouts–Arizona Cactus-Pine Council, Inc. (“the Council”)

Election: Each Girl Scout Governing Area shall be entitled to elect one voting member for every 50 girls in that Governing Area registered with the GIRL SCOUTS OF THE U.S.A. on September 30 of the year prior to the Annual Council Meeting. Voting member elections shall be held at least 90 days prior to the Annual Meeting at which the voting members will serve.

A quorum for the election of voting members shall consist of eight percent of the registered members who are 14 years of age, or older, on or before September 30 of the year prior to the Annual Council Meeting, and affiliated with the Governing Area.

Purpose: To form the collective voting member body representing the Council’s entire membership. To listen to and participate in discussions of issues at the Annual Council Meeting. To vote on issues or for elective candidates that each voting member believes will represent the best interest of the Council.

- Responsibilities:**
- Elect the officers of the Council, the members-at-large of the Board of Directors, the Older Girl Scout Advisory Members of the Board of Directors, fourteen (14) to eighteen (18) years of age, the members of the Council Nominating Committee, and the National Council of GSUSA voting members and alternate voting members.
 - Vote on amendments to the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws and take all other action requiring a vote of the voting members.
 - Conduct such other business as may, from time to time, come before the voting members.

Voting members must be a registered member of the Girl Scouts of the USA and members in good standing of “the Council.” It is also important that voting members attend a voting member training session and be familiar with Robert’s Rules of Order.

In the event a voting member is unable to attend the Annual Council Meeting, each voting member must be sure their voting member materials are given to an elected alternate voting member selected to fill the vacancy.
