Building on her Bronze Award project, she sought to support hospitalized children by providing them with art materials. What started as a simple idea to host a crayon drive grew into a collaborative effort, with multiple Girl Scout troops coming together to collect supplies, write letters, and educate youth on the importance of recycling and community involvement. In its first year, Caring Through Color donated 25 lbs. of art supplies to Scottsdale Shea Medical Center and recycled 104 lbs. of used crayons.
