

# Job Description Parking Volunteer

## Summary/Objective:

The role of the parking volunteer will be to help direct vehicles both on and off site for Jamboree. The main objective for this role is to keep girls, chaperones, volunteers, and staff safe while enforcing strict speed limits and minimizing traffic congestion.

Reports to: Volunteer Leader

#### **Essential Functions:**

- Direct both passenger and gear vehicles to their designated location
- Enforce traffic pattern (1-way routes, restricted pathways)
- Enforce speed limits
- Assist in getting adult driver to and from satellite parking lot
- Ensure vehicle are efficiently parked to maximize parking spaces

### Required Certification, Qualification, and Experience:

- For the roles required to drive a golf cart or transport vehicle (Satellite Parking Lot Runner):
  - o Valid driver's license
  - o Clean driving record

#### **Physical Demands:**

- Standing for long periods of time
- Navigating uneven terrain

#### **Time Commitment:**

- 5 hours Friday (3:00pm-8:00pm)
- 3 hours Sunday (6:00am-9:00am)
