

Volunteer Description Saturday Evening MC

Summary/Objective:

The Saturday Evening Program Master of Ceremonies position should be able to complete the following duties: introducing troops to the stage for all present at Jamboree. Further ensuring the transition between program sections and making sure time constraints are followed.

Reports to: Jamboree Coordinators

Essential Functions:

- They meet with organizers to learn about the overall event, the agenda, the presenters
 and any special guests, and they may even contact the presenters to confirm their
 roles.
- The MC prepares an introduction for each speaker and each part of the event. They can also prepare a formal agenda if the organizers haven't created one.
- At the event, the MC checks that the presenters and special guests are present, follows the agenda and ensures that the various sections of the occasion start and end on time.

Physical Demands:

- Navigating uneven terrain occasionally
- Lift and carry 30 lbs.

Time Commitment:

• Friday meeting touch base, at least 3-hour time commitment for Saturday evening programing. At least a 1-hour meeting online prior to Jamboree.

Jamboree is a pivotal Girl Scouting tradition where Girl and Troop Leaders gather in celebration, fun activities, and outdoor challenges to grow their courage, confidence, and character.
