

Summary/Objective:

Skill Challenge Judge plays a key part in making the Jamboree experience meaningful for girls. Skill Challenge Judges receive training in order to perform their duties at the event. Prior experience is preferred in some areas including shelter building, fire building, orienteering, knots and lashings.

Reports to: Skill Challenge Coordinator

Essential Functions:

- This position requires the Skill Challenge Judges to provide mentorship and guidance through feedback to girls while determining a patrol's skill level based on a standard set of criteria.
- Skill Challenge Judges will fill out score cards to determine skill level.

Physical Demands:

- Navigating uneven terrain occasionally
- Lift and carry 30 lbs.

Time Commitment:

- Preliminary instruction through conference call and/or mail or e-mail prior to the event. You will volunteer a minimum of 4-5 hours Saturday. If the Skills Challenge Coordinator decides it's necessary, there will be an in-person meeting Friday. If we are short of skilled volunteers, the time commitment could be longer

Benefits:

Jamboree is a pivotal Girl Scouting tradition where Girl and Troop Leaders gather in celebration, fun activities, and outdoor challenges to grow their courage, confidence, and character.
