Service Team Position Description

SUMMARY Advise the Service Team on the needs of girls and participate in Service Team tasks to supplement your Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

SUPPORTED BY Older Girl Advocate and Service Team

APPOINTMENT Girls who are Seniors or Ambassadors who express interest are welcome to join the Service Team with approval from Older Girl Advocate and MSE.

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

- » Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE) utilize the opportunity to take on leadership roles and learn-by-doing in a safe, fun, and cooperative environment.
- » Work with the Older Girl Advocate in the Service Unit to provide the "girl perspective" on Service Team activities. Participate in a variety of GSLE activities alongside the Service Team such as outdoor or camping occasions, community service opportunities, field trips or events, product programs, and badges/journeys/awards. Utilize your experience to help inform Service Team practices.
- » **Girl-Led** Take the lead and grow skills by leading duties that interest you! Use the opportunity to take on Service Team tasks with the support of an adult volunteer on the Service Team.
- » **Learning by Doing** In the safe environment of the Service Team, try new roles and responsibilities. Shadow different roles of the Service Team, participating alongside adult volunteers and learning through trial and error.
- » Cooperative Learning participate in the Service TEAM with respect, collaboration, and teamwork. Notice both your team of girls and team of adults and note how to foster an environment of cooperation.

REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- » Be a Senior or Ambassador at the time of joining the Service Team.
- » Recommended Program Aide and Volunteer-in-Training and Counselor-in-Training. Earn at least one Leader in Action Award.
- » Present a positive image of Girl Scouting to girls, volunteers, and community members.
- » Be guided in all actions by the Girl Scout Mission, Promise, and Law.
- » Be a registered member of GSACPC.
- » Participation in Authentic Leadership Community workshops recommended.

I understand any information/records that I may see through my participation on the Service Team which are considered confidential must be respected as private information. I further understand that the purpose of my participation on the Service Team is to enhance my Girl Scout Leadership Experience and should not be considered mandatory.
