## THE TREFOIL TRADITION

Juliette Gordon Low patented the design for the original three-leafed Trefoil membership pin on February 10, 1914. The three leaves stand for the three parts of the Girl Scout Promise and the design contains the traditional American symbols of an eagle, a shield, a shaft of arrows, and an olive branch.

The design of a new contemporary membership pin was led by the first African-American President of GSUSA, Dr. Gloria Scott. During her tenure from 1975 to 1978, she called the organization to a higher awareness of diversity and inclusiveness. As a result, the contemporary Trefoil membership pin features three forward-looking profiles, representing Caucasian, African American and Hispanic/Native American girls and symbolizes Girl Scouts' continuing commitment to be a safe place where all girls feel welcomed.

We are honored to continue the legacy started more than 100 years ago. The Trefoil holds the foundation and long history of Girl Scouts. We are thrilled for you to take part in our tradition!

## WHAT IS THE TREFOIL TRADITION PROGRAM?

The Trefoil Tradition program is a unique membership group for individuals who support the tradition of Girl Scouting and want to continue to invest in girls in our community. Trefoil Tradition members are invited to attend two exclusive annual events (in February and April) that will touch on pertinent topics facing girls and women in Arizona. The starting investment for members is \$1,000, which will go directly to supporting our annual operating costs to reach and serve more girls.
