



INCH WORM OF SERVICE

Service is an integral part of Girl Scouting. The most meaningful service is a two-way sharing, when Girl Scouts give help to someone, but also make friends in the process.

To be counted, all Inchworm hours need not be done within the troop. Individual Inchworm hours may be counted, but not for doing chores which are the regular contribution of the girl to her family life.

INSTRUCTIONS

Attendance at troop meetings or troop events is not considered service. Selling cookies and/or calendars is not counted, the troop bonus is the reward for girls.

Inchworm hours are accumulated from project to project and from year to year within each age level. **A girl may earn more than one patch within her level.**

- Record each girl's service hours by inches. **ONE HOUR = ONE INCH**
- Inchworm of Service Record form PS-31b is available at the Member Resource Center located in the Council Shop and online at www.girlscoutsaz.org.
- To be eligible to wear the Inchworm patch, a girl must earn inches as follows:

• Girl Scout Daisy	10 inches (hours)	Blue Inchworm
• Girl Scout Brownie	15 inches (hours)	Brown Inchworm
• Girl Scout Junior	20 inches (hours)	Green Inchworm
• Girl Scout Cadette	25 inches (hours)	Yellow Inchworm
• Girl Scout Senior	30 inches (hours)	Yellow Inchworm
• Girl Scout Ambassador	35 inches (hours)	Yellow Inchworm

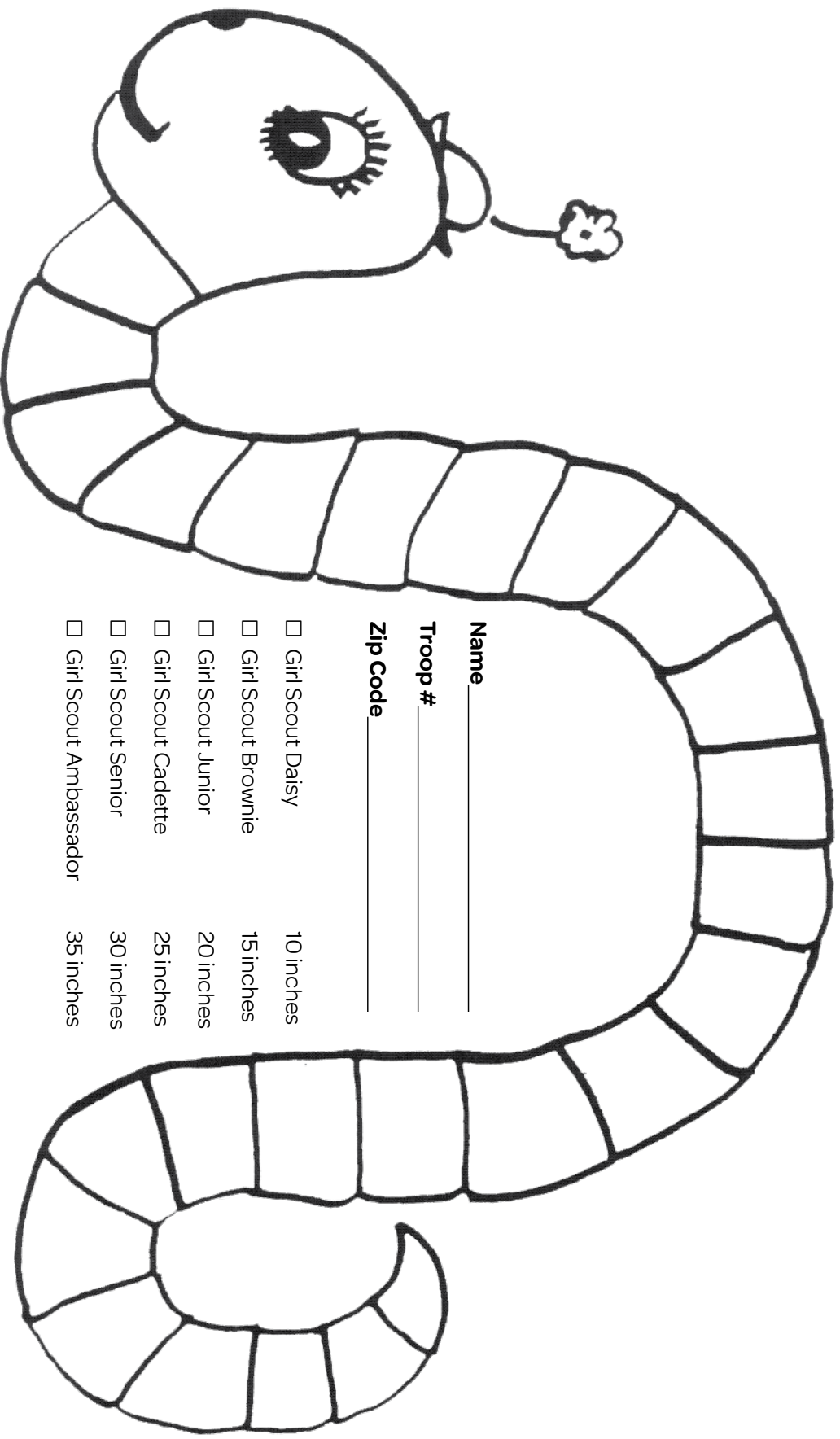
