Here is how to support your daughter in participating during the Fall Product Program.

With your help and support, she will have the opportunity to improve on valuable life skills such as goal setting, decision making, business ethics, money management and people skills.

What Girls Need to Participate

A signed Parent Permission Form on file with her troop or IGM Coordinator.

A Fall Product Program packet, which includes a candy/nut paper order card, money envelope and a M2 online flyer with information about how to set up an online storefront.

For participation electronically, Internet access and parental supervision is required.

Participating Online

Beginning October 1, girls create an online account in the M2 system (see October 1 on right for details on getting started).

Within her online account, she creates an avatar with her own virtual likeness, enters e-mail addresses and creates a personal message to send to family and friends. As a way to increase her sales, we also suggest she record her voice for her avatar or upload a personal video explaining what her troop plans to do with the money earned. She then launches her campaign and her personal message is sent with links for her customers to shop for magazines and/or candy/nut items.

Girls should create their online account and send out e-mails early in the program to allow maximum time for their customers to make a purchase.

M2 system collects payment at the time of an online order (via credit card) for all products ordered online (including girl-delivery candy/nut items).

All orders placed online (including girl-delivery orders) are automatically added to the M2 System so parents need not record/enter any online sales.

Dates to Remember

October 1

Fall Product Program begins! Click link in launch e-mail from the council, click on rotating banner on the council website at www.girlscoutsaz.org, or go to www.gsnutsandmags.com/gsacpc to get started with the online component of the program. Girls can also begin taking orders on candy/nut order card.

October 25

Last day to take orders for candy/nut items that will be delivered by girls.

October 26

Last day to enter in-person orders for girl-delivery candy/nut items in the M2 System. Do not enter girl-delivered online nut orders as these are already in the system.

November 14-20 Extended Area Delivery November 21-22 Metro Area Delivery

Candy/nut items delivered. Check with your troop volunteer for location, date and time to pick up your candy/nut items for girl delivery.

November 30

Online sales end for magazines and candy/nut items that are shipped directly to customers at 11:59 p.m. (est)

December 2

Recognition selections due in M2 System.































































Girls Can Earn One Patch That Looks Like Them!

Girls and troop volunteers can create their own M2 avatar. Log into www.gsnutsandmags.com/gsacpc. Avatar patches will be mailed directly to each girl who earns them at the end of each program. Girls should ensure their correct mailing address is entered in the M2 system.

Girls earn a 2020 Fall Program personalized avatar patch by:

- Creating their avatar
- Selling \$350 or more magazines, candy and nut items (includes Online and Girl Delivered candy/nut items)











Candy/Nut Order Card - Product and Selling Information

Customers make their selections by completing the information on the order card.

Items ordered on the order card in online girl-delivery candy/nut items are delivered to your area in November. Check with your troop volunteer for your pickup date, time and location.

Spread the Word

Girls can print out the flyer on the M2 site with her personal store code to distribute to potential customers. Each girl's special code grants customers access to their account to order their favorite magazines so both she and her troop receive credit for the sale.

Payments

Payment for all candy/nut orders taken on the order cards must be collected at the time of delivery and turned in to your troop volunteer as soon as possible. Ask your troop volunteer about speific turn in dates.

Payment is collected online from the customer for all online orders when the order is placed (including girl-delivery candy/nut items).



Care to Share

Each girl who sells at least ten items for our Care to Share service project will earn a special patch. Our Care to Share program sends delicious candy/nut items to our military through Packages from Home.

Troop Proceeds and Girl Rewards

Girl rewards and troop proceeds are automatically calculated in the M2 system.

Troops will earn:

- \$1 on \$1-9.99 snack items
- \$2 on \$10-19.99 snack items and magazines
- \$3 on \$20+ snack items

Girls can earn the rewards depicted on the order card and on our council website. Rewards are cumulative, which means the girl earns the rewards to the sales level achieved. As orders are placed, girls can log into their online site to see what they have earned as well as make their reward choices.
