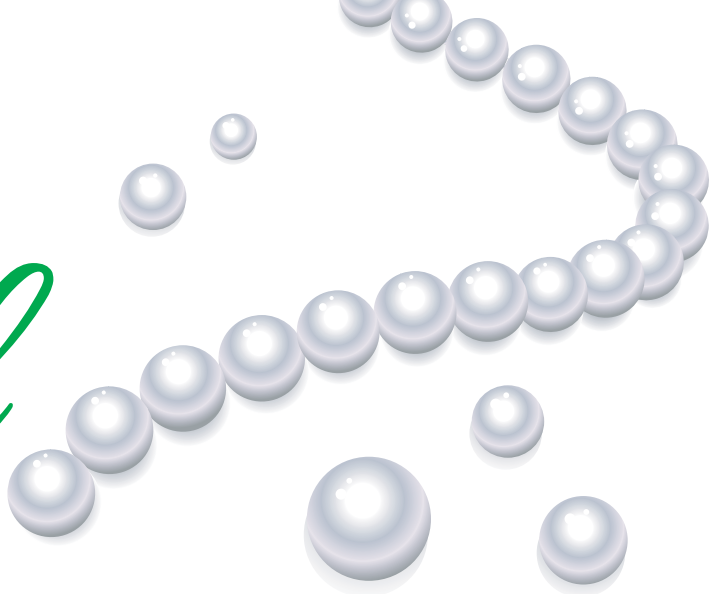

WHY TROOP PEARL?

In order to launch the Girl Scout Movement in 1912, Girl Scouts' founder, Juliette Gordon Low, sold one of her prized possessions, a strand of pearls. The first Girl Scouts blazed trails and redefined possibilities for themselves—and for girls everywhere. They played basketball. They hiked, swam, and they camped. They learned to tell time by the stars. But most importantly, they shared a sense of adventure and a belief that they could do anything. And just like Girl Scouts do across the country and around the world today, they offered a helping hand to those in need and worked together to make their corner of the world a better place.

Today the pearl stands for giving something of value for other people's dreams to come true. Troop Pearl allows women who were Girls Scouts to continue to build on the scouting spirit and for women who were not a part of scouting growing up to connect with the Girl Scout sisterhood power, because it is never too late to be a Girl Scout. Troop Pearl will reconnect with the adventure and values of girl scouting through four annual experiences that would be similar to (with an adult tweak) experiences that local Girl Scout troops are experiencing.

We're excited to continue grow our sisterhood through CAMEO conversations. Caring and Mentoring Each Other is a space for us to connect, facilitate relationships, rejuvenate, relax, spend time together, commit to personal growth while encouraging others to do the same. CAMEO locations and times will be shared in upcoming Troop Pearl newsletters.

WHO CAN BE PART OF TROOP PEARL?

- » Must be 21 or older
- » Commitment to lead by the Promise and Law
- » Desire to seek adventure and sisterhood
- » Commitment to attend 2 of the 4 experiences per year

WHAT IS THE COST?

\$75 annual fee and cost of experiences. \$25 of these dollars will go towards your adult membership fee and the remaining \$50 will go into our financial aid fund to allow all girls to experience Girl Scouting. If you are a current member, your full \$75 fee will support our financial aid fund.

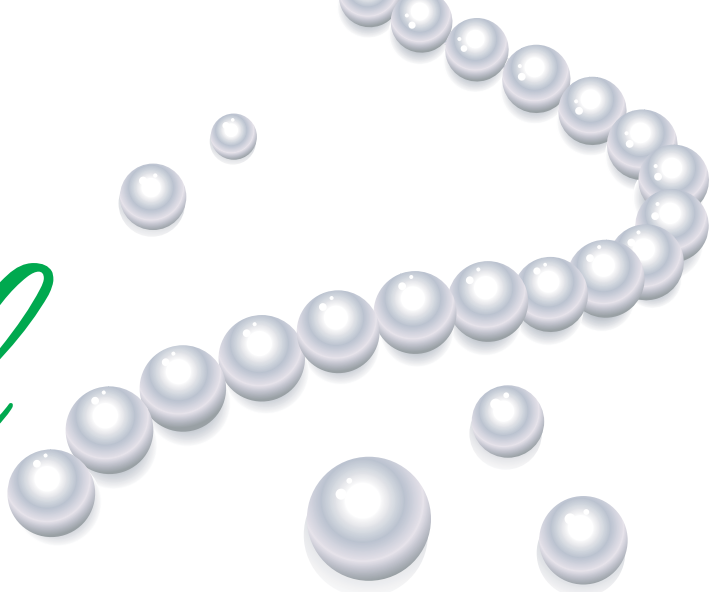
