

GSACPC Large Group Gatherings

Quick Sheet – Phase Two

Please be aware that while your overall group size may exceed 50 people, cohort groups should not exceed 50 people. Groups may only reach 50 people indoors with adequate spacing and ventilation/airflow. Cohorts must be established once on-site. Cohorts may not intermingle for the duration of stay.

Two of Three Rule

All participants must always have at least two of the following three things in effect:

1. Participants are outdoors
2. Wearing mask/face covering
3. Physically distanced (by at least 6 feet)

Eating Areas

- It is highly recommended that a caterer is utilized for food service while at Girl Scouts facilities.
- Servers must be utilized for meals. Individuals may not serve themselves.
- Girl Scouts' building usage and related capacities will be managed by each individual property. Please contact the camp/location if you have questions about capacities.

Indoor Facilities

- Bathrooms must be cleaned once daily.
- If communicable disease (i.e., stomach flu, influenza) presents itself in any participant, facilities must be cleaned as soon as possible.
- The capacity of each building has been assessed by the Camp Manager and is not to be exceeded. Capacities will be communicated prior to arrival in confirmation packets.
- Please review building capacities and ventilation at non-GS facilities.

Cleaning/Sanitizing

- High-touch surfaces must be cleaned at least once daily (doorknobs, handles, light switches, etc.)

- All food areas must be cleaned and sanitized after every meal. Please use the appropriate cleaners for the facility. Contact the Camp Manager if you have questions about what cleaners to use at a specific Girl Scouts property.
- Hand sanitizer is provided throughout each Girl Scouts facility. Sanitizer should be utilized as your group moves throughout the facility. When visiting offsite facilities, hand sanitizer and cleaning products must be made available in each space.

Program Areas

- Rarely can a Girl Scouts program area (i.e., archery, climbing wall, pool) accommodate 50 people at once.
- Please be aware for scheduling that cohort groups may have to be split in half to visit program areas.
 - Each half of the cohort group will visit a program area, and then they will switch.
- Multiple cohorts cannot visit a single program area at once.
- Please plan appropriately for the amount of time it will take to move split cohorts through activity areas.
