

G.I.R.L. CHAMPION

Service Team Position Description

SUMMARY The G.I.R.L. Champion will act as a connector between Girl Scouts and a school (or group of schools) or organization (place of worship, sports center, youth organization, etc.). The Champion will work with the Recruitment Manager and the appropriate council staff to recruit and connect new adults and girls to Girl Scouting.

SUPPORTED BY Recruitment Manager, Member Support Executive (MSE), Member Placement Specialist and the Service Unit Team.

APPOINTMENT Appointed by MSE for one year; reappointment based on annual evaluation.

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

- » Develop good relationships with the school(s)/organization staff.
- » Promote Service Unit and Council-Wide recruitment efforts.
- » Represent GSACPC at your school(s)/organization's parent gatherings (open house, meet the teacher, kindergarten orientation and children's activities/events) to welcome and recruit new parents and girls to Girl Scouts.
- » Share excitement and passion for Girl Scouts by facilitating parent information nights and/or other recruitment events.
- » Generate interest and recruit parents/guardians to become Girl Scout Troop Leaders/Volunteers to form/join a Girl Scout Troop.
- » Help connect new Troop Leaders or girl members to the Member Placement Team to place girls in an existing troop or to form a new troop.
- » Communicate progress to Recruitment Manager, Member Support Executive and Member Placement Specialist.
- » Attend relevant meetings and other scheduled events as appropriate. (Examples: Service Team meetings, Leader meetings, Service Team planning meetings, trainings, etc.)

REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS TO BECOME A G.I.R.L. CHAMPION

- » Present a positive image of Girl Scouting to girls, volunteers, and community members.
- » Comply with all GSUSA and Council policies and procedures, including Volunteer Essentials, recognize, understand, accept, and support all Council goals and objectives, including the Diversity Equity and Inclusion Statement.
- » Be guided in all actions by the Girl Scout Mission, Promise, and Law.
- » Be a registered member of GSACPC with a current background check.
- » Complete G.I.R.L. Champion training.
- » Leadership from the Inside Out online resource recommended.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge that I have read, understand and agree to all responsibilities and requirements listed in the G.I.R.L. Champion Service Team Position Description. In addition, as a volunteer serving in a service team position, I understand that some of my work will involve access to information/records that are considered confidential.
